Dear Mr Buckley

Please find enclosed papers that relate to a decision taken by the Home Secretary to deprive you of your British citizenship.

In light of your circumstances, as the partial descendent of someone incorrectly granted citizenship due to political error by a previous government, the notice of the Home Secretary's decision has been served on file today (13<sup>th</sup> May), and the order removing your British citizenship has subsequently been made. Copies of each are included with this letter.

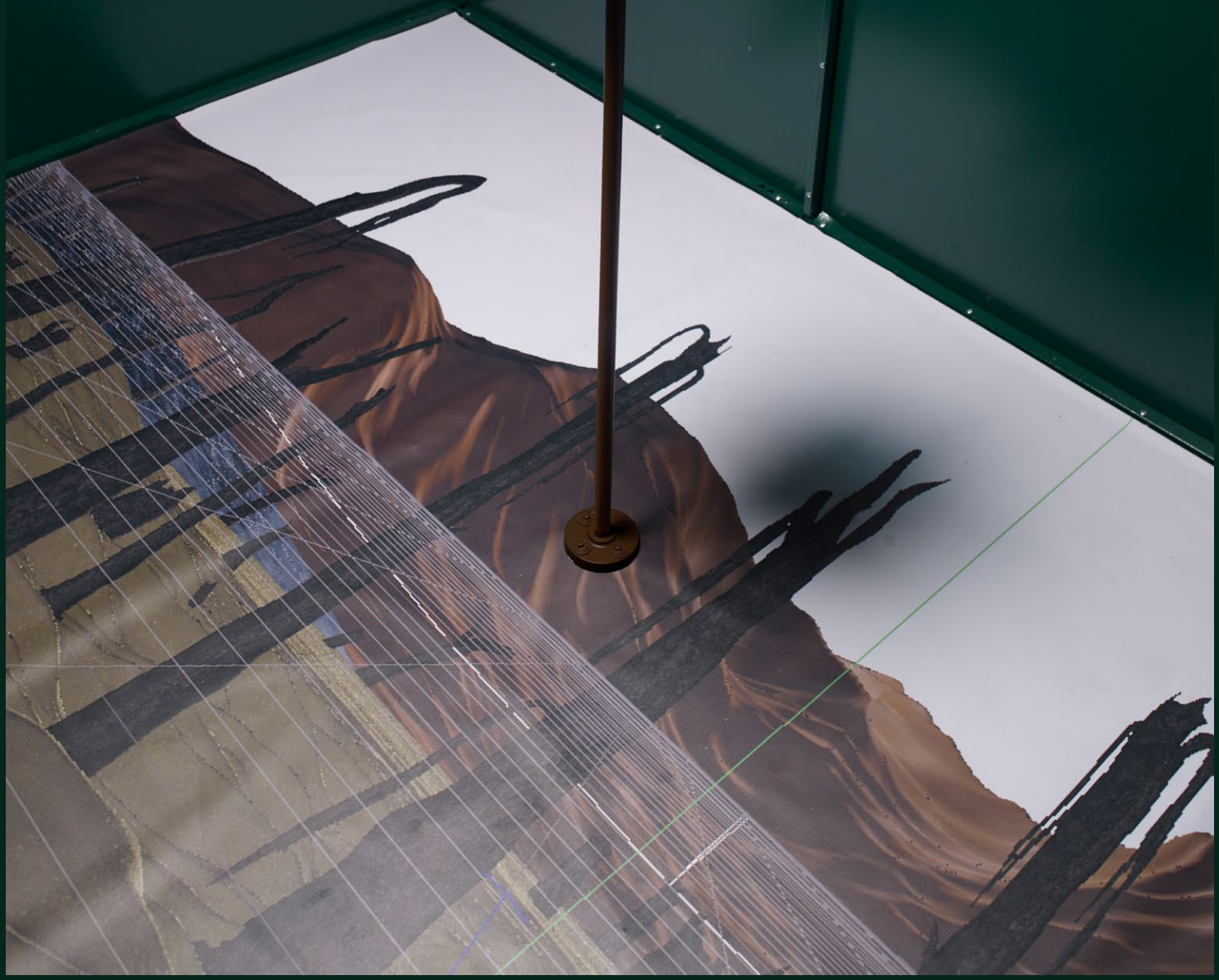
You now have 30 days (until the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2024) to leave the United Kingdom. If at such a time you are unable to afford the costs associated with repatriation, then the Home Office will assist you in your repatriation with the costs incurred being your responsibility to pay back. Wage garnishing schemes are available.

Due to the nature of this citizenship error, this decision is not open to appeal at this time.
